Last week in PKC, our students were introduced to letter "C". They learned all about caterpillars, and we studied the life cycle of a butterfly. We loved reading the book "The Very Hungry Caterpillar", which tells the story of how a butterfly begins as an egg, becomes a caterpillar, grows a cocoon, and then changes into a butterfly.
